K233CG LICENSE APPLICATION
COMPLIANCE WITH SPECIAL CONDITIONS

Special operating conditions or restrictions, as shown on construction permit BPFT-20110923ADB:

1. The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

COMPLIANCE: Educational Media Foundation, in coordination with other users of the site, agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect workers and others having access to the site, support structure or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

2. Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.

COMPLIANCE: Program test operations will commence after the filing of this application.

3. Warning signs which describe the radiofrequency electromagnetic field radiation hazard must be posted at appropriate intervals. Access must be restricted to prevent the exposure of humans to RF emissions in excess of the FCC guidelines (OET Bulletin 65, Edition 97-01, released August 1997). Permittee shall submit documentation of compliance with this special operating condition when filing FCC Form 350, application for license.

COMPLIANCE: Warning signs have been posted on the sides of the building that supports the antenna system as shown in the photographs on the following page. The translator station is located within an established Forest Service electronic site that employs gated access. Please see the pictures below for the placement of the signs:
