An Environmental Assessment is not required, as grant of this application would not be considered a major environmental action.

The proposed (existing) WLVQ auxiliary transmitting antenna, an ERI FMH-2E spaced 1 wavelength, will be side mounted on a tower that has been registered with the Commission. No change is proposed in the overall height of the tower above sea level.

The proposed transmitting facilities will comply with the FCC guidelines limiting human exposure to radio frequency energy. The maximum power density level at ground level, calculated in accordance with OET Bulletin No. 65 (August 1997), would be less than 5% of the applicable limit for exposures of unlimited duration. Accordingly, the proposed facility is categorically excluded by FCC Rules from having to consider the contributions of other stations at the site. If work is done on the tower in an area where over exposure could occur, the Licensee in coordination with the other users will take necessary action to prevent the overexposure of workers on the tower including reducing the transmitting power or ceasing operation completely.
