
Dear Madam Secretary:

On the behalf of **Maryland Media One, LLC** ("MMO"), the Licensee of WHGM (AM), Havre De Grace, Maryland (FAC# 35120) ("Station"), this is to respectfully request an Extension Special Temporary Authority ("STA") granted in BESTA-20220131AAI (copy attached). This Extension is needed while MMO completes its construction pursuant to BMP-2021129AAC (Granted March 7, 2022). The Licensee expects construction to be complete in the next sixty (60) days. Since construction has not been completed, we require a further STA extension.

This is in reference to the request filed on January 31, 2022. MMO requests a further extension of the STA granted on February 6, 2014, to continue operating from an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to cover BMP-20211229AAC.¹ In support of the request, we noted that MMO plans to file the application after BMP-20211229AAC has been found acceptable and granted by our staff.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and MMO may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Hours of operation	Daytime only
Operating power	0.01 kW


¹ WHGM(AM) is licensed for operation on 1330 kHz with 5 kW day (ND), and 0.5 kW night (DA), and BMP-20211229AAC proposes a daytime 1 kW and nighttime 0.018 kW ND antenna system at the licensed site.

Antenna type	ANXX center-loaded, vertical whip antenna
Electrical height of radiator	4.8°
Antenna efficiency	50 mV/m/km/kW

MMO must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **August 3, 2022**.
