The proposed facility would comply with the provisions of Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules. No change in the location of the KXBZ transmitter site is proposed. In addition, Manhattan would not acquire any other facilities. As a result, no change in the concentration of ownership of facilities within either the Salina-Manhattan, Kansas or Topeka, Kansas markets would result.

In addition, a contour based study is also provided via the attached two maps. The first map depicts the common overlap between the Manhattan facilities that define the contour based market. This market is created from the common overlap of four facilities, three of which are FM stations. As a result, it is necessary and sufficient to demonstrate that Manhattan would control less than fifty percent of the facilities serving the contour defined market. The second map demonstrates that there are at least five additional facilities serving the market with transmitter sites located less than 92 kilometers from the perimeter of the common overlap.
