New Northwest Broadcasters LLC (“NNB”), licensee of radio station KXDD(FM), Yakima, Washington (the “Station”), pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission’s Rules (47 C.F.R. §§ 73.1560(d), 73.1635), respectfully requests extension of special temporary authority (“STA”) for NNB to operate the Station at variance from its licensed parameters. Despite its diligent efforts, NNB has been unable to restore full power operations due to circumstances beyond its control.

On October 28, 2005, the FCC granted STA for NNB to operate the Station at a reduced power of 40 kW during repair or replacement of the Station’s main transmitter, which had experienced a major failure on September 1, 2005. (BSTA-20050930BMX). At the time that NNB initially filed for STA, it believed that the Station’s main transmitter could be repaired and placed back into service. Upon receiving the required parts and attempting to repair the transmitter, however, NNB determined that the transmitter needed to be replaced. NNB ordered a new transmitter promptly, but the manufacturer has been unable to deliver the equipment in a timely manner. The manufacturer has now further delayed delivery because of labor problems affecting its production facility. NNB conferred with the manufacturer during the week of April 10, and has been assured that delivery will occur within the next few weeks. Upon delivery, NNB plans promptly to install the new equipment and return the station to its full operating power.

In view of the foregoing, NNB respectfully requests an extension of STA to operate KXDD(FM) with parameters at variance from its licensed parameters.
