Dear Ms. Dortch:

Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna, Inc. ("CCVE"), by its attorney, Dan J. Alpert, ESQ., mailed us a copy of their letter filed with you dated July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and emailed to Ms. Parul Desai, Esq. and James Bradshaw, both with the FCC. I acknowledge receipt of this letter. (Copy attached).

I am also attaching a copy of the Letter dated June 28, 2017 that the FCC Directed to Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna titled "Interference Complaint" where "CCVE" was ordered expressly to comply, in detail, to contact EVERY complainant KTWL listener to address their concern with gross interference received by them from "CCVE" and their K287BQ translator and report back to the Commission in a strict and timely thirty-day period. Pretty clear.

Under penalty of perjury, I, Roy E. Henderson, the Licensee of Full-Service station KTWL-FM 105.3, Todd Mission, TX, hereby state that I have been informed by involved administrative personnel that "CCVE" and K287BQ have FAILED to contact OR even address virtually ANYONE (and there are many) of these individual KTWL listeners about their concerns of interference to KTWL-FM from "CCVE" and K287BQ... to date! This, despite the fact Mr. James Bradshaw, Deputy Chief of the FCC Audio Division of the Media Bureau specifically ORDERED "CCVE" to contact every one of them...within 30 days of the Commission's June 28, 2017 Letter. Why did "CCVE" do this? It is obvious to us and clearly implied by "CCVE" counsel, that "CCVE" felt it ONLY had to "conditionally" comply with Mr. Bradshaw's clearly stated orders imposed on it. They could have, at least, contacted these complaining listeners and asked them, since July 12<sup>th</sup>, the date of their stated "new" facility going on the air, if they were still receiving interference from K287BQ. But they did not. Nothing, nothing at all... except the "boilerplate" letter counsel for "CCVE" sent to the Commission on July 27, 2017. "CCVE" should not be allowed to extend the time allotted them to complete what they were told to do by the Commission. I respectfully ask the Commission to grant NO further extension to "CCVE" beyond the 30 days allotted them to complete their FCC requirement.

Since "CCVE" did virtually none of what it was ordered to do by the Commission, I must respectfully insist that the FCC immediately order the non-complying K287BQ off the air, as clearly stated in the June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017 letter, until ALL interference to KTWL-FM is or can be eliminated, as mandated by FCC Rules, and to immediately protect Full-Service KTWL and all its clearly identified listeners that had the courage to come forward and complain against interfering K287BQ. These people DESERVED within the last thirty days to be heard from "CCVE", because it is in the public's interest. And they wanted to present their grievances to and be recognized... by the Commission.

"CCVE" counsel is quoted as saying that..." In the event new complaints are filed, "CCVE" intends to deal with them in a timely matter."

WE do NOT believe they will, and the Commission itself has experienced the same thing from this licensee not only in Texas, but in other states and proceedings that have come before it that involves it and its principals, which is a matter of record. No one, including Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna, as a Commission licensee, should be allowed to misrepresent to the FCC, as this licensee has proven to have done.

We believe "CCVE" and its principal is again "playing for time" while KTWL-FM risks bankruptcy because we at KTWL-FM are suffering financially by "CCVE" and its documented interference, while they "skip" their translator all around Houston trying to defy the laws of physics. Houston's terrain is extremely flat and when combined with its close proximity to the Gulf of Mexico and all its negative signal nuances, there is NO reasonable way that KTWL-FM and K287BQ can co-exist as "co-channels" in the same market without inducing real world interference between the two signals. If K287BQ is to exist, it must do so on a different channel and not on 105.3 FM (channel 287).

Additionally, by and through its FCC counsel's July 27, 2017 letter to the Commission, "CCVE" misrepresents.... once more to the Commission, again, lying to the Commission that they, as stated on K287BQ's license, were rebroadcasting KODA-FM 99.1 HD-2. This is totally false and Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna and its principals *continue* to "dupe" the Commission as they have done so many times before by showing a "lack of candor" legally, technically, and in actual practice. Here is what Dan J. Alpert specifically states in the 7/27/17 Letter to the Commission, **"It also should be noted that contrary**



**to allegations raised by Mr. Henderson in the course of emails to the FCC, Station K287BQ is rebroadcasting the HD-2 channel stream of Station KODA(FM). That HD-2 channel stream is being programmed by Dabang Radio, which has entered into a contractual relationship with CCVE to rebroadcast that HD-2 program stream from KODA(FM) on Station K287BQ."**

Also in the same letter:

**"It (K287BQ) is rebroadcasting Station KODA, as reported to the Commission."**

These are totally false statements. Please read the attached Statement, marked Exhibit "A-1" by one of Houston's leading and operating broadcasting Chief Engineers, Mr. A.D. Rigmaiden. I hereby state, under penalty of perjury, that Mr. Rigmaiden is in no way work-related or associated in any way or manner with KTWL, or its Owner and employees, whatsoever.

Since we are hereby attaching many more "KTWL Listener Complaint Letters" to this important filing in response to "CCVE" and its obvious "lame, lazy, and cavalier" letter sent to the Commission in response to the Commission's Order to properly respond by July 28, 2017, that Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna and its illegal translator station K287BQ that ...OPERATES THEIR "NEW" FACILITIES OF JULY 3<sup>RD</sup>, 2017, AS STATED BY "CCVE", AND CONTINUES, TO THIS DATE, TO FLAGRANTLY AND ILLEGALLY INTERFERE WITH OUR FULL-SERVICE STATION, KTWL-FM 105.3 (287C-3), TODD MISSION (HOUSTON), TX.

Finally, since Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna ("CCVE"), its principals, its attorney, and their K287BQ translator operating on the co-channel of KTWL (287C-3, 105.3 FM) have FAILED to follow the direct orders of the Commission's letter sent to "CCVE" on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017, and since we continue to receive KTWL Listener Complaint letters long after "CCVE" stated change of facilities filed with the Commission on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 (as shown in the attached Listener Complaints letters), I strongly urge and respectfully ask the Commission to immediately order K287BQ turned off, pending resolution.

We continue to receive bonafide specific complaints from our listeners up to and including today. They will be included with ALL other Complaint Letters that have been submitted to "CCVE", its counsel, and the Commission, until this matter is resolved.

Additionally, under penalty of perjury, I hereby state that K287BQ, with its current iteration, continues to cause serious interference to KTWL even within its 60 dBu contour signal, as affirmed by complaining listeners included herewith and attached along with the many others already submitted to you and the Commission.

We formally ask the Commission to recognize that KTWL-FM has suffered long enough the gross interference, lies, lack of candor, misrepresentations, unrecognized transmitter site locations, over power wattage, and all other abuse to it AND the Commission, including the FCC Enforcement Division and its Dallas Field Office agents, have had to put up with by Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna's adverse and illegal deeds by its K287BQ and K231CN translators, in Houston, for *far too long*. We ask the Media Bureau to act immediately to stop all this without any more delay and to please do what it is supposed to do in protecting FULL-SERVICE radio stations like KTWL-FM.

We pray for relief for the beleaguered KTWL and we pray for it now.

**Interference Complaint**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Centro Cristiano de Vida Eterna, Inc. ("CCVE"), by its attorney, hereby responds to the interference complaint filed by Roy E. Henderson on June 7, 2017. The Complaint alleged that K287BQ was interfering with the reception of KTWL(FM), Todd Mission, Texas with respect to facilities licensed in BLFT-20170426ACI.

Even prior to the time the Complaint was filed, CCVE filed an application for modification of its license (File No. BPFT-20170512AAG), which was granted on May 31, 2017. The new location, which was approved by the Commission, is located approximately 11 kilometers from the location for which the Complaints were filed. The operation also is for operation at significantly lower height above ground level (199 meters vs. 299 meters) and lower effective radiated power (0.06 kW v. 0.099 kW).

The Station construction at the new site was completed on July 2, 2017, and a license to cover the construction permit (File No. BLFT-20170703AAK) was filed on July 3, 2017. An informal objection was filed against the license application on July 10, 2017. However, operations at the new site pursuant to automatic Program Test Authority did not commence until July 11, 2017.

There are no pending complaints that have been filed against K287BQ dated after July 11, 2017 or which deal with K287BQ's current operation. It is hoped and anticipated that due to the changed operating parameters that have been undertaken, any interference that has been experienced by listeners of KTWL has been eliminated, and that no new complaints will be filed. In the event new complaints are filed, CCVE intends to deal with them in a timely manner.

It also should be noted that contrary to allegations raised by Mr. Henderson in the course of emails to the FCC, Station K287BQ is rebroadcasting the HD-2 channel stream of Station



KODA(FM). That HD-2 channel stream is being programmed by Dabang Radio, which has entered into a contractual relationship with CCVE to rebroadcast that HD-2 program stream from KODA(FM) on Station K287BQ.

In short, Station K287BQ is broadcasting in full accord with the Commission's rules and policies at a new, authorized transmitter site. It is rebroadcasting Station KODA, as reported to the Commission. It remains under the full control of CCVE, and there has been no "transfer of control" to be reported to or investigated by the Commission.

**Interference Complaint**

Dear Licensee:

This refers to the interference complaint filed by Roy E. Henderson on June, 7, 2017 (Complaint). The Complaint alleges that K287BQ is interfering with the reception of KTWL(FM), Todd Mission, Texas.

Pursuant to 47 CFR § 74.1203, K287BQ is required to eliminate any actual interference it causes. Therefore, it is necessary for K287BQ to submit a detailed report on each complaint even if the complainant might have been addressed in a previous proceeding. For each complaint, the report must include: (1) the name and address of the complainant; (2) specific devices receiving the interference (i.e. type of device, manufacturer's name, model number, and serial number); and (3) any assistance provided by K287BQ for each device allegedly receiving the interference and whether such interference persists. Each of the complaints must be addressed individually.

The Commission's Rules regarding FM translators restrict FM translator stations to operate strictly on a secondary basis and limit their service. Section 74.1203(a)(3)<sup>1</sup> states that an FM translator station will not be permitted to continue to operate if it causes any actual radio signal interference to the direct reception by the public of the off-the-air signals of any authorized broadcast station.<sup>2</sup> Actual interference is based on listener complaints indicating that the signal they regularly receive is being impaired by the signal radiated by the FM translator station. Section 74.1203(b)<sup>3</sup> states that if the interference cannot be properly eliminated by the application of suitable techniques, the operation of the offending FM translator station shall be suspended and shall not be resumed until the interference has been eliminated.

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

<sup>2</sup> An FM translator station creating actual radio signal interference to any authorized broadcast station is obligated to eliminate the interference, regardless of the location where the impaired signal reception occurs.

<sup>3</sup> 47 CFR § 74.1203(b).

Within thirty days of this letter, K287BQ must take appropriate actions required by the provisions of 47 CFR § 74.1203 to resolve all complaints of interference to fulfill its obligations. Further action on this complaint will be withheld for a period of thirty days from the date of this letter to provide K287BQ an opportunity to respond. Failure to correct all complaints within this time may require K287BQ to suspend operation pursuant to 47 CFR § 74.1203.
