On December 12, 2001, the Commission adopted the reallocation of television Channels 52-59 from use by television broadcast. *Reallocation and Service Rules for the 698-746 MHz Spectrum Band (Television Channels 52-59)*, GN Doc. No. 01-74, Report & Order, 17 FCC Rcd. 1022 (2002). Accordingly, on March 8, 2002, KB filed a petition for rulemaking seeking Commission authority to substitute NTSC Channel 46 for NTSC Channel 56 at Wiggins, MS. On September 23, 2002, the Commission granted this request. See Report & Order, MM Doc. 02-152, DA 02-2368, released September 27, 2002. This Report & Order becomes effective November 11, 2002.

KB Prime Media LLC is an applicant for a new DTV full-power television station in the following community:

On July 17, 2002, pursuant to a filing window for certain pending NTSC applicants proposing television operations on Channels 52-59, KB Prime Media filed a petition for rulemaking proposing the substitution of Channel 57 for Channel 62 at Hammond. Subsequently, the Commission adopted the reallocation of television Channels 52-59 from use by television broadcast. *Reallocation and Service Rules for the 698-746mHz Spectrum Band (Television Channels 52-59)*, GN Doc. No. 01-74, Report & Order, 17 FCC Rcd. 1022 (2002). In response to that action, KB amended its pending petition to specify the substitution of DTV Channel 42 for NTSC Channel 57. On September 13, 2002, the Commission granted this request. See Report & Order, MB Doc. No. 02-131, DA 02-2282, released September 19, 2002. This Report & Order becomes effective November 4, 2002.

Pursuant to a pending settlement agreement, KB Prime has withdrawn its pending application for a construction permit for a new full-power television station on Channel 41 at Alexandria, Louisiana, in exchange for consideration.
