

**USE OF THE STATION FOR
ADVANCEMENT OF AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**

La Promesa Foundation was formed as a Section 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation "exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, scientific and literary purposes". La Promesa is an existing educational broadcaster (see Form 314, Exhibit 16 for its current list of stations); it has been found qualified under 47 CFR §73.503 to operate stations in the non-commercial, educational portion of the FM band as well as to have AM stations licensed to it as "non-commercial educational". The educational purposes of La Promesa Foundation are to provide regular educational radio programming designed to teach the Bible and the Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church in a manner which can be utilized by local Roman Catholic schools as well as by the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine educational programs administered by local Roman Catholic parish churches.

La Promesa currently operates WMET for the advancement of an educational program similar to what is aired on La Promesa's existing radio stations currently. In particular, La Promesa intends to broadcast programs to

teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church. In so doing, La Promesa substantially relies on the radio service of Eternal Worldvision Network (EWTN). In this endeavor, WMET(AM) is being operated in a manner similar to that at La Promesa's existing stations.

EWTN's programming is commercial-free, and there is no paid programming which is aired on EWTN. Programming consists of the following basic types: (1) broadcasts of "Interactive" programs such as "Catholic Answers"; (2) recorded programs presented by eminent Roman Catholic professors and scholars dealing with various topics of the Gospels and Roman Catholic catechism (categories 1 and 2 occupy a majority of the broadcast day); (3) Roman Catholic Masses, the Holy Rosary and various recitations of Litanies and the Stations of the Cross; and (4) newscasts and public affairs programs such as "The World Over" with host Raymond Arroyo.

A current program schedule for La Promesa stations is attached hereto.

Thus, the programming to be presented over WMET presents a comprehensive daily effort to educate the public, Catholics and non-Catholics, about the tenets and dogmas of the Roman Catholic faith, including the Bible and the systematic Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church.

La Promesa Foundation intends to work with local Roman Catholic parishes, catechism programs and organizations to assist their educational efforts with respect to teaching of the Catholic religion; in sum, we will provide a valuable educational resource for the residents of Gaithersburg and surrounding areas in the Washington, DC metropolitan area. This is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.
