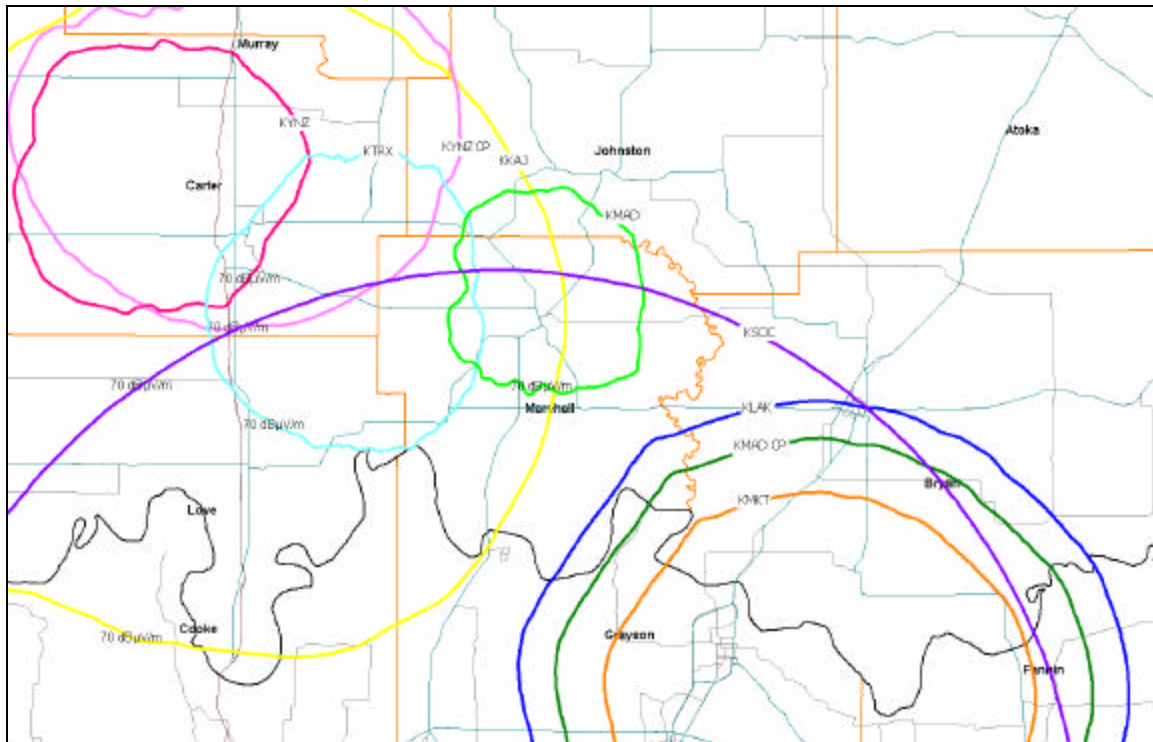


NM Licensing performed a multiple ownership study for the following stations to determine eligibility for ownership of Chuckie Broadcasting Company stations.

City Grade Contours For Studied FM Stations

KMAD 273A Madill, OK has a construction permit to relocate to 273C2 in Whitesboro, TX.  
KYNZ 294A Lone Grove, OK has a construction permit to relocate to 296C3 Lone Grove, OK.

Both licensed signals and construction permit signals are included in this study.

KMAD 273A licensed to Madill, OK overlaps KSOC, KKAJ, KTRX and KVSO. A multiple ownership study of these signals yield a signal count of 80 stations and an ownership limit of 8 stations with 5 in one service.

KMAD 273C2 construction permit licensed to Whitesboro, TX shows no overlap with the Chuckie Broadcasting Company Stations.

KSOC overlaps with NM Licensing's KMKT, KLAK, KMAD and KMAD CP signals. A multiple ownership study of these signals yield a signal count of 74 stations and an ownership limit of 8 stations with 5 in one service.
