Pursuant to a request by Hank Hardisty of Broadcast Works, I did cause an on the ground observance of four antennas on the KBJR radio tower in the Absolom Gibson Survey, Abstract No. 22, Cherokee County, Texas. The following represents the findings at the present time. Two Trimble 5700 GPS receivers were used to set azimuth marks on a true bearing of North 26 deg. East, and South 41 deg. West as provided by Hank Hardisty. A 1/2" steel rod was placed at one azimuth mark North 26 deg. East, 2181.9 feet from the center of the tower. A Topcon GTS 605 series total station was then used to observe the antennas from the azimuth mark. Both of the antennas pointing North 26 deg. East appeared to be correct and were verified by Hank Hardisty on the ground. A 1/2" steel rod was placed at the other azimuth mark South 41 deg. West, 1998.8 feet from the center of the tower. Again the Topcon GTS 605 was used to observe the other two antennas. Both of the antennas pointing South 41 deg. West appeared to be correct and were again verified by Hank Hardisty on the ground.

I, Kristopher Morgan do hereby state that this report represents the facts of an observance of four antennas on the KBJR radio tower made on the ground for BROADCAST WORKS, and that in accordance with the information and the instructions furnished me, same correctly represents the facts as found at the time of the survey.
