


CERTIFICATION THAT WTJU-FM IS NOT STUDENT RUN

The University of Virginia (legal name: Rector and Visitors of the University of Virginia) is the licensee of WTJU-FM, Charlottesville, VA. WTJU-FM is not a student-run station; rather, this station is managed by a professional staff of 4.5 FTE employees. In addition, the station is programmed predominantly by non-students. The station has approximately 120 volunteer on-air hosts, who report to volunteer department directors and the General Manager / Program Director. There are some students who volunteer as hosts at WTJU, they only account for about 10% of the station's on-air programmers. Student programmers are supervised by the professional General Manager / Program Director.

CERTIFICATION THAT PROPOSED LPFM WILL BE STUDENT RUN

The proposed LPFM in this application will be managed and programmed by students on a day-to-day basis. There is already a group of more than 40 students at the University of Virginia operating a webstream-only station. That station's Manager and Program Director are both third-year students, and all hosts and producers at that station are students. This proposed LPFM would supply an FM frequency for this student-run station, allowing it to extend its reach and impact to the University of Virginia community.


