This proposed DTV flash cut for the noted facility would not have a significant environmental impact since it is for an existing communication facility at an established Translator site. All users of the site have agreed to lower power or temporarily cease operation when workers may be exposed to high levels of radio frequency radiation as they perform tower related work. Transmit antennas are at an elevation, above ground, that yields only very low amounts of radio frequency electromagnetic radiation at ground level thereby posing no danger to the general public who may gain occasional access to the site. The translator output power will not be increased from the currently authorized analog facility, so there will not be any additional electromagnetic radiation emitted.
