Request for Silent Special Temporary Authorization

Digital TV Translator Station W33CR-D, Chambersburg, PA (Facility ID: 73081)

Pursuant to Sections 74.763(b) and 73.1635 of the FCC's Rules, WITF, Inc. ("WITF"), licensee of digital TV translator station W33CR-D, Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, respectfully requests a three-month Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") to allow WITF to maintain the station's current off-air status.

As explained in an August 8, 2012 Notification of Suspension of Operations filing with the FCC, WITF was forced to temporarily suspend operations over Station W33CR-D on July 30, 2012 due to equipment problems beyond its control. Specifically, the station was forced off-air due to the failure of power supplies following violent storms which caused extreme power fluctuations. WITF has been diligently working toward restoring service, and had hoped to do so before 30 days of off-air status. However, due to a delay in the delivery of replacement parts, the station remains off-air as of this date, and WITF therefore seeks the requested STA. A grant of STA will serve the public interest by allowing WITF the necessary time to take delivery of the replacement parts and complete the repair of the W33CR-D technical facility as needed to restore service to the public.

WITF is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates this translator on a noncommercial educational basis in connection with its co-licensed noncommercial educational full service parent television WITF-TV. This request is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements, pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the Commission's Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules.
