

Notice of Reduced Power Operation**

Dear Ms. Dortch

On behalf of Blueberry Broadcasting, LLC, licensee of FM broadcast station WTQX, Boothbay, Maine, the Commission is hereby notified, pursuant to Section 73.1560 (d) of the rules, that on July 30, 2015, the WTQX main transmitter failed and the station resumed operations with a backup transmitter at approximately 20% of its authorized power of 15.5 kW. It is estimated that reduced power operation of WTQX may be necessary for a period of 60-90 days pending the purchase and installation of a new transmitter; accordingly, a request for special temporary authority for reduced power operations will be filed on or before August 29, 2015.
