Pursuant to Section 73.3517 of the Commission's Rules, Salisbury Broadcasting Colorado, LLC ("SBCLLC"), licensee of Station KTUN(FM), Eagle, Colorado, submits its application for minor change in licensed facilities. Specifically, SBCLLC is proposing to downgrade Station KTUN(FM) from Channel 268C to Channel 269C1 at its licensed transmitter site. This application is contingent with the simultaneously filed amendment to construction permit application of On-Air Family, LLC ("On-Air"), which proposes to upgrade the KBRU-FM facilities from Channel 269A to Channel 268C at a new transmitter site.
