COMMUNITY OF LICENSE CHANGE

SSR Communications, Inc. (“SSR”), respectfully requests that the Commission allow WYAB to change its community of license from Benton, Mississippi to Flora, Mississippi, particularly as the Commission has already deemed that such moves are in the best interests of the public.

In MB Docket Number 06-52, the Commission determined that a second local aural transmission service at Flora was worthy of consideration, but then dismissed the proceeding after the initial petitioner (MissAla RF) failed to file supporting comments for its own initial petition for rulemaking. As a result, the Commission dismissed the entire proceeding in 2006.

SSR asserts that Flora is deserving of a second local service from WYAB, particularly as SSR operates WYAB’s studios within the Flora city limits. SSR has already demonstrated its dedication to providing Flora and Benton (WYAB’s present community of license) with daily local news, sports, and information, in the spirit of the Commission’s directives for local broadcasting service.

As previously stated in Exhibit 22A, Benton would not be deprived of its sole local service if WYAB’s community of license were changed to Flora. Station WXTN has already committed to serving Benton via its application BP-20070702CUL. Brad Maurice Cothran, Licensee of WXTN, has confirmed to SSR that he is ready to serve Benton immediately, upon the grant of the WXTN Construction Permit.
