Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 15, 2013, on behalf of Townsquare Media Lubbock License, LLC ("TMLL"). TMLL requests a second extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted September 18, 2012 to continue operating Station KZII-FM with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680.¹ The original STA authorized such operation because KZII-FM's transmission line had burned out. TMLL later determined that the tower is overstressed and must be reinforced. TMLL has since decided to replace the tower and is looking into that matter.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control, and that it has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

¹ KZII-FM is licensed for operation on Channel 273C1 (102.5 MHz) with effective radiated power of 100 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 249 meters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KZII-FM may continue to operate with reduced power.

TMLL must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. TMLL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 19, 2013**.
