

Compliance with Condition 3 on CP
WCMF-FM FCC 302 Application
CBS RADIO STATIONS INC.

CBS Radio Stations Inc. (“CBS”), the licensee of WCMF-FM, Rochester, New York, has installed an auxiliary antenna, at a multi-user transmitter site located at geographic coordinates 43° 08’ 05” North Latitude, 77° 35’ 07” West Longitude (NAD27). A condition (#3) on the Construction Permit required CBS to submit documentation demonstrating compliance with the requirement to place warning signs and restrict access to areas of the site that exceeded the permissible radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure.

The entire site was surveyed with the results showing that the highest level measured was .11mW/cm² at any areas accessible to the general public. The highest level measured at all other restricted areas on the ground was .312 mW/cm².

The following are photographs illustrating the signs that are in place at the site warning of the possible RF environment. The entire site is restricted by a locked fence. In addition, a separate fence secures the area around the base of the tower.
