Dear Ms. Archilla:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 23, 2019. OBC requests a further extension of the STA granted on February 6, 1991, to operate ND at night using 5 kW due to interference from co-channel station HICV, Barahona, DR¹. In support of the request, OBC states that the interference continues.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and OBC may continue to operate using the licensed ND facility with a maximum power of 5 kW at night (with no change to the licensed daytime 1 kW operation). This authority is subject to termination upon reduction of power or cessation of operation by HICV, or upon Commission

instruction to resume licensed operations per BZ-19791004AD. OBC must reduce nighttime power if complaints of interference are received.

This authority expires on **December 12, 2019**.
