Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to station KIMG-LP, Ventura, California. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that KIMG-LP has been silent since March 9, 2009.² Accordingly, the STA request BLSTA-20100216ABk is HEREBY DISMISSED and construction permit BDFCDTL-20100127ABU and license for KIMG-LP IS HEREBY CANCELLED and the call sign IS DELETED.
