
Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration: (1) the above-captioned application for a new FM translator in Delta Junction, Alaska on Channel 271; (2) the Petition to Deny filed by Northern Radio, Inc. ("NRI") filed on October 29, 2003. For the reasons set forth herein, we deny the Petition to Deny and all related pleadings.

NRI is the licensee of KYSC(FM), Fairbanks, Alaska. NRI purports that the proposed translator will be in violation of Section 74.1231(g). NRI states that K290AA, licensed to the applicant, "is currently selling commercials on K290AA in violation of Section 74.1231(g) of the Commission's Rules and TBC intends to sell commercials on its proposed translator in violation of that rule." However, the petitioner has not demonstrated that the proposed translator will be in violation of Section 74.1231(g). In addition, the K290AA website fails to suggest that Turquoise is violating any other Commission rule. NRI purports that the application violates § 74.1231. The translator proposes to receive the signal from the primary station via the internet. The applicant requests a waiver of § 74.1231 based on commercial "white area". A study shows that there is commercial "white area" therefore the waiver is granted and the issue is moot.

Accordingly, the October 29, 2003 Petition to Deny IS HEREBY DENIED. Furthermore, application BNPFT-20030821AAA IS HEREBY GRANTED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
