RESOLVED that the Authorized Officer shall be, and hereby is, authorized, directed and empowered to retain, on behalf of the Company the law firm of Jones, Walker, Waechter, Poitevent, Carrere & Denege, L.L.P. ("Jones Walker"); and it is further
