Mission Broadcasting, Inc.

As described in greater detail below, an application (FCC File No. BTCCDT-20110714AAT) (the “Transfer Application”), currently is pending for consent to the transfer of control of Mission Broadcasting, Inc. (“Mission”), the proposed assignee of WTVW. The Transfer Application seeks consent for the transfer of Mission’s stock from the Estate of David S. Smith (Nancie J. Smith, Executor) to Nancie J. Smith, in her individual capacity. Mr. Smith was Mission’s sole shareholder at the time of his death. Nancie J. Smith is his widow and Mission’s Vice President and Secretary.

This exhibit sets forth both Mission’s current ownership and the ownership proposed in the Transfer Application. Mission respectfully requests that, in the event that the Transfer Application is granted prior to the present application, the Commission allow Mission to consummate the transaction proposed in the Transfer Application and acquire WTVW with the ownership structure set forth therein. In the event that the Transfer Application is not granted prior to the present application, Mission respectfully requests consent to acquire WTVW with the ownership structure that exists today.

David S. Smith, the sole shareholder of Mission, died on March 28, 2011. As a result, pursuant to the jurisdiction of the Mahoning County, Ohio probate court, Mr. Smith’s stock was transferred to his estate. Nancie J. Smith, Mr. Smith’s widow and Mission’s Vice President and Secretary, is the Executor of Mr. Smith’s estate. Mission’s current ownership is as follows (*see also* BTCCDT-20110526AHD):

Mission's ownership, as proposed in the Transfer Application, is as follows:

Both potential ownership structures result in Mrs. Smith having control over Mission's stock and Mrs. Smith and Mr. Thatcher being Mission's only officers/directors. Therefore, although the Transfer Application is not *pro forma* in nature, each proposed ownership structure involves the evaluation of the same parties' qualifications. The answers to the questions in the assignee's portion of this application (Section III) will be accurate for either of the two possible ownership structures.

Mission respectfully requests consent to acquire WTVW with whichever of the above-described two ownership structures exists at the time this application is granted.
