

Multiple Ownership Study Supplemental Showing

The following engineering statement and attached exhibits have been prepared for Three Eagles Communications, Inc., licensee of several broadcast facilities in the Watertown and Brookings, South Dakota vicinities, and are in support of a supplemental showing for a multiple ownership study pertaining to the acquisition of additional facilities in those regions.

This supplemental showing seeks to alleviate potential questions concerning to facilities in which the attributable interest of Three Eagles is to be divested. Specifically these two facilities are FM station KZNC(FM) at Huron, South Dakota, and standard broadcast station KIJV(AM) also at Huron, South Dakota. Assignment of these facilities to another entity has been approved by the Commission; however, the transfer has yet to be consummated. As a result, this supplemental showing will demonstrate that if Three Eagles were to continue to hold an attributable interest in these facilities, the acquisition of the facilities described in the multiple ownership study to which this study is a supplement would still be in compliance with the provisions of the Commission's Rules.

The map in this exhibit is a copy of the map depicting the facilities that would be under common control contained in the multiple ownership study, with the addition of the principal community coverage contours of KZNC(FM) and

KIJV(AM). In addition to depicting these contours, pink shading has been included to depict the markets that would arise from these stations. In the case of both markets, there is only one FM station and one AM station is involved. Specifically the northeastern market is comprised of common overlap between KIJV(AM) and KDLO-FM, while the southwestern market is comprised of the common overlap between KZNC(FM) and KIJV(AM).

Since one station from each service is involved in the composition of these two markets, and there is no common overlap with additional stations to which there is an attributable interest held by Three Eagles, then it is respectfully submitted that these two markets would be in compliance with the provisions of Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules. Furthermore, since these two markets would be in compliance, and there is no common overlap with any of the orange shaded markets, which are those studied in the multiple ownership study, it is also respectfully submitted that were Three Eagles to continue holding an attributable interest in KZNC(FM) and KIJV(AM) that this situation would not be an impediment to the market groupings described in the multiple ownership study.
