Family of God Fellowship Church, Inc. (“Family”), applicant for the above-referenced new Low Power FM Station at Topeka, Kansas, herein updates its previous reports, filed June 30 and July 30, 2014, to state that significant progress has been made with respect to preparation of a study to demonstrate that Family’s proposed LPFM facilities comply with the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.


As previously reported, Family is working with Dynamic Environmental Associates, Inc. (“DEAI”). DEAI reports that, shortly after it submitted the required FCC Form 621 with the Kansas State Historic Preservation Office (“SHPO”), the SHPO issued a letter dated August 21, 2014 indicating the proposed antenna structure would have no adverse effect on the subject property.

Family, working with DEAI, now needs to obtain Tribal clearance for the project. Sixteen Tribes have expressed an interest in the project location; five of those Tribes have already cleared the project. We anticipate that the Tribal consultation process will be completed within 45 days.

This letter is being filed in response to the Audio Division's letter of May 13, 2014. Further updates will be submitted each 30 days until such time as DEAI's study has been completed and Family has been able to amend its application to make an affirmative environmental certification.
