Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed October 25, 2007, on behalf of Mount Rushmore Broadcasting, Inc. ("MRB"). MRB requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") originally granted on March 19, 2003, to operate Station KAWK from a site other than the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, MRB states that, following a long and unsuccessful search for a new site, it filed a proposal in MM Docket No. 05-98 to change the community of license. MRB states that, since the Commission has released a Report and Order in MM Docket No. 05-98, it expects that its problem may be satisfactorily solved. MRB states that it has been involved in negotiations to sell Station KAWK, in which case the assignee will file an application for construction permit to relocate the station. MRB further states that, in the unlikely event that an application for assignment is not filed, it will file its own application for construction permit.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ KAWK is licensed for operation on Channel 286C1 (105.1 MHz) with effective radiated power of 7 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 400 meters.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KAWK may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Channel	286 (105.1 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.018 kilowatts (H&V)
Antenna height:	
above ground:	13 meters
above mean sea level:	1641 meters
Above average terrain:	-49 meters

MRB must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. MRB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **October 29, 2008**.
