Dear Mr. Lipp:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 2, 2013. SHU requests further extension of the STA granted on October 19, 2005, to operate from a site other than the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, SHU states that it continues to search for a new transmitter site (to propose a new site facility using FCC Form 301).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WSHU may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates:	41° 07' 42" N, 73° 23' 26" W, (NAD 1927)
Frequency	1260 kHz
Hours of operation	Unlimited
Operating power	Not to exceed 0.25 kW daytime; 0.002 kW nighttime
Antenna type:	Temporary, wire

¹ WSHU is licensed to Westport, Connecticut, for directional operation on 1260 kHz with 1 kW day and 0.009 kW night.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. SHU must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 25, 2014**. Failure to file an acceptable FCC Form 301 application for a new site before the expiration date shown above may lead to a denial of any further requests for extension, and cancellation of the original STA.
