Dear Staff:

Calvary Chapel of Twin Falls, Inc.(CCTF) respectfully notifies the Commission that WUJC St. Marks, Facility ID 122209 began operating at low forward power, with high reflected power, on 11/28/2015. A CCTF engineer visited the site and has not been able to determine what the problem is, but suspects that the transmission line or the transmit antenna has been damaged. Arrangements are being made to climb the tower and check the line and antenna for problems, which will be at least a week from the date of this filing. However, because the transmitter began showing signs of stress, WUJC was turned off on 12/3/15 until the problem has been identified and fixed.

If normal operations have not resumed within the specified 30 days, an STA request will be electronically filed for WUJC St. Marks.
