Hello Mr. Manarchuck:

I'm asking if it's possible for this email to serve as an informal STA request for WASR, Wolfeboro NH. Facility number 54889.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic ad revenue has fallen to near zero. After much thought, and as an alternative to going silent we must ask permission to run WASR at 1000 watts daytime instead of its licensed 5000 watts from its existing site for a period not exceeding 180 days, though we hope it will be much less. Night power will not be affected. Any help you can provide would be appreciated. We hope to hear from you soon. Thank you.
