Tolling

Dear Mr. Garziglia--

On August 21, 2018, we received the request for tolling of the construction deadline for a construction permit (File No. BNPFT-20180420AAW) (permit) for FM Translator Station W239CR, Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania Facility ID No. 202203, that you filed on behalf of Sound Ideas Media, LLC (SIM). The permit was granted on June 8, 2018, for a three-year term, expiring on June 8, 2021. In your request you state that after the permit's grant, an informal objection and petition for reconsideration of the grant were filed and dismissed, and an application for review of the grant of the permit was filed on August 13, 2018 and remains pending. This request falls within one of the criteria for tolling in 47 C.F.R. §73.3598(b) and is granted. Pursuant to §73.3598(c) of the rules, this request is timely. I have placed a note in the station's record in our public database indicating that the request has been granted.

Grant of the request is subject to the following conditions:

Tolling is effective as of June 8, 2018. Once tolling ends, 3 years will remain on the permit.

Tolling will remain in effect until February 21, 2019, absent earlier resolution of the application for review. If the matter is not resolved within six months, SIM would need to file a status report by February 21, 2019, and at six-month intervals thereafter, requesting continued tolling treatment.

SIM also must notify us within 30 days of the application for review being resolved.

These status reports must be sent by letter to Secretary, FCC, 445 12 St, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20554 with a courtesy copy by e-mail to Victoria.McCauley@fcc.gov.

When tolling ends (either because SIM has not filed a request for continued tolling or because the matter has been resolved) we will calculate a new permit expiration date by adding the remaining 3 years.
