Notification of Temporary Suspension of Operation

Station KCPT-DT, Kansas City, MO (F.I.N. 53843)

Public Television 19, Inc. ("Public TV 19") hereby notifies the FCC of the silent status of noncommercial educational DTV Station KCPT-DT, Kansas City, Missouri.

Public TV 19 temporarily suspended operation of Station KCPT-DT on April 19, 2006. Public TV was forced to take KCPT-DT off-air due to equipment problems with the KCPT(TV) analog facility located at the same antenna tower site. As Public TV 19 notified the FCC by letter dated April 3, 2006, it had begun temporary reduced power operation of the analog KCPT(TV) facility in March, as necessitated by technical problems. Specifically, a design failure in the station's combiner had created an arc. After further examining the technical problems and the plan and timetable for the required equipment repairs, Public TV 19 filed a request for Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") for analog KCPT(TV) on April 10, 2006.

Most recently, on April 19, 2006, Public TV 19 temporarily took digital KCPT-DT off-air, as technically needed in order to attempt to restore full power operation for analog KCPT(TV). Public TV 19 currently hopes to restore the permanent full power licensed operation for digital KCPT-DT (in addition to analog KCPT(TV)) in approximately three weeks. Should it become necessary to maintain the silent status of digital KCPT-DT for more than one month, Public TV 19 will request STA for the extended off-air period.

Public TV 19 is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates KCPT(TV/DT) on a noncommercial educational basis. This request is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1114 of the Commission's Rules, and the station is exempt from FCC regulatory fees pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules.
