Special Operating Conditions

Mapleton License of Spokane, LLC (“Mapleton”), licensee of K223BD, St. Maries, Idaho, holds a construction permit (BPFT-20160729AKZ) (the “Authorization”) for operation on Channel 231 at Spokane, Washington (“K231CU”).

The FCC imposed a condition on the Authorization that states:

“BEFORE PROGRAM TESTS COMMENCE, sufficient measurements shall be made to establish that the operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements of 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d). All measurements must be made with all stations simultaneously utilizing the shared antenna. These measurements shall be submitted to the Commission along with the FCC Form 350-FM application for license.”

Mapleton is not operating a shared antenna at this location. At the time it filed its application to modify the facilities of K223BD to operate on Channel 231, Mapleton operated an auxiliary antenna for its co-owned station KBBD(FM), Spokane, Washington, on the tower on which K231CU’s antenna is installed. The antennas for both facilities would have been located at the same height, but Mapleton has removed the auxiliary antenna for KBBD(FM). Concurrently with the filing of the instant application, Mapleton is surrendering the FCC authorization for the KBBD(FM) auxiliary (*See* BXLH-20160408AAM). Because the translator is not sharing an antenna, spurious emissions measurements are not required.
