Explanation of Circumstances Warranting Grant of STA

Pappas TV Americas de Omaha, LLC (“TV Americas de Omaha”) holds a license from the Commission that authorizes TV Americas de Omaha to operate low-power television station KCAZ-LP in Columbus, Nebraska (the “Station”) on NTSC Channel 57. Station KCAZ-LP bears the Commission’s Facility Identification Number 21157.

As we notified the Commission in our letter to the Commission’s Secretary that was dated and filed with the Commission on behalf of TV Americas de Omaha on November 21, 2007, the Station temporarily suspended broadcast operations on November 12, 2007, due to financial constraints. TV Americas de Omaha is actively working to develop a strategic plan for the optimal use of the Station’s resources in order to resolve this situation, and so that the Station may resume its broadcast service at the earliest practicable date.

Accordingly, as required by Section 74.763(b) of the Commission’s Rules and Regulations, KCAZ-LP respectfully requests a special temporary authorization (“STA”) from the Commission to permit Station KCAZ-LP to remain “dark” for more than 30 consecutive days. It is hoped and believed that an STA of six (6) months duration will prove sufficient to resolve the Station’s current operational/financial challenges. The public interest will be served by a grant of the STA, because this STA will allow Station KCAZ-LP to continue serving its viewers, once its challenging financial situation is resolved.
