During the LPTV/ TV Translator Auction 81 Filing Window, Eastern New Mexico University tendered an application to construct a new television translator broadcast station for Artesia, New Mexico for channel 29(-). This application was assigned file number BNPTT-20000829AOO.

The Commission has determined that this application may be mutually exclusive with other applications in the MX Group M38. An interference study has been conducted to determine those applications that may be mutually exclusive.
