On May 18, 2001, the Allocations Branch granted the petition for rulemaking filed by
Chester P.
Coleman, licensee of Station KADX(FM), Houston, Alaska, requesting the substitution of
Channel 234C1
for Channel 234C2 at Houston, Alaska, and the modification of Station KADX's license to

reflect the change, as well as the license of Station KNIK-FM, Anchorage, Alaska from Channel 287C1 to Channel 286C1. Since Station KNIK-FM has subsequently been modified to Channel 289C1 by application (see File No. BPH-20010105AAT granted on March 8 2001), we hereby rescind our action modifying Station KNIK-FM to Channel 286C1. We also modify paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 to remove reference to Station KNIK-FM.
