

**Description of Educational Objectives and How Station
Will Be Used to Advance Assignee's Educational Program**

Good News for Life (“GNL”) is a nonprofit educational organization. Upon consummation of the proposed transaction, GNL will operate radio station WRGN(FM), Sweet Valley, Pennsylvania and its associated FM translator stations in the advancement of its educational program.¹

GNL plans to broadcast educational, cultural, and entertainment programming to the public for the purpose of advancing the following educational objectives:

- (1) Provide educational and religious instruction;
- (2) Provide the opportunity for, and promoting of, informative discussion and debate in areas pertaining to contemporary social and religious issues;
- (3) Provide educational programming regarding problems in the community such as drug and alcohol abuse, depression, codependency, mental health issues, problems within the family unit, and education; and
- (4) Provide educational programming with respect to enhancing one's personal and family life.

In order to achieve its educational objectives, GNL will broadcast a number of regular features and programs designed to advance its various educational objectives. A representative example of programs that will fulfill those objectives are the following:

The Urban Alternative: This half hour program is designed to address issues facing urban families, restore hope and transform lives through the proclamation and application of the Word of God. Tony Evans, the first African-American to graduate with a doctoral degree from Dallas Theological Seminary, hosts the program.

New Life Live: This is a nationally syndicated call-in radio and TV show with host Steve Arterburn, who offers listeners advice on dealing with problems such as addiction, depression, ethics, codependency, emotional and family issues.

In The Market: Host Janet Parshall challenges listeners to examine major news stories, issues being debated in the marketplace of ideas, and then speaks to them with the Word of God. In this fast-paced, caller-driven program, Janet evaluates newsworthy topics with guests and listeners using the Bible as a framework for discussion. This daily program addresses relevant issues important to Christians, with an engaging mix of listener interaction and commentary from highly respected guests.

¹ The proposed assignee is a non-profit, non-stock corporation organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The articles of incorporation provide that the corporation is organized for religious, educational, charitable and literary purposes, all of which are to be accomplished in a charitable manner.

Focus on the Family: This program provides assistance and resources to couples to enable them to build healthy marriages that reflect God's design, and to parents to help them raise their children in accordance with the morals and values grounded in biblical principles. The broadcast also helps families protect themselves from the harmful influences in our society and equip themselves to make a greater difference in the lives of those around them.

Truth For Life: Alistair Begg hosts this Bible-teaching ministry which seeks to faithfully proclaim the Word of God. The program addresses a variety of life's challenges, yet always points back to the authority and truth of God's Word.

Parenting Today's Teens: This daily radio program is heard on over 900 radio outlets, and the topical weekend program is heard on over 750 radio outlets throughout North America. Mark Gregston, who hosts the program, uses wit and wisdom, shared through stories and reflections of his involvement with teens to bring biblical insight and practical guidance to his listeners to share his heart about families and teens. Lessons learned from those who have struggled with their teens are communicated to parents preparing their child for the teen years, or find themselves caught in the turbulent adolescent years with their teen.

Family Talk: Psychologist Dr. James Dobson and the Family Talk team make use of the radio, the worldwide web, and social media to offer assistance and encouragement through this strategically designed program to reach the younger generation with the Judeo-Christian worldview of the family.

Living On The Edge: Chip Ingram's passion is helping Christians really live like Christians. As a pastor, author, coach and teacher for more than twenty-five years, Chip has helped believers around the world move from spiritual spectators to healthy, authentic disciples of Jesus by living out God's truth in their lives and relationships in transformational ways.

SRN News: Originating from its state-of-the-art international News Center just 10 minutes from the White House and Capitol Hill, SRN News fields a team of the finest anchors and reporters in Christian journalism providing on-the-spot coverage of breaking news from around the world, which will air at the top of each hour.

As demonstrated herein, GNL will primarily offer religious educational programming, programming provided by national syndicated religious and educational organizations, news, entertainment programming, and public service announcements to fulfill its educational objectives.
