

Memorandum of Agreement

Western Broadcasting, LS, LLC ("Western") licensee of Station KURR(FM), Channel 276, Hurricane, UT, FCC Facility ID No. 164147; CBL Investments, LLC ("CBL") licensee of Station KBZB(FM), Channel 255C1, Santa Clara, UT, FCC Facility ID No. 78999; and Dixie College ("Dixie") permittee of station KXDS(FM), Channel 217C3, St. George, UT, FCC Facility ID No. 173065 (collectively, the "Parties"), hereby evince their agreement to each file simultaneously with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), pursuant to the Report and Order in MB Docket 05-210, 71 Fed. Reg. 76208 (December 20, 2006), an FCC Form 301 Application for KURR(FM) and KBZB(FM) and an FCC Form 340 for KXDS(FM) for Minor-Change Construction Permits.

In BPH-20070727AFG, Western was permitted to change KURR(FM)'s community of license from Hurricane, UT, to Indian Springs, NV. A third party station had proposed to replace KURR(FM) at Hurricane so as not to deprive that community of its sole local service. The replacement station has since opted not replace service Hurricane and has sought reconsideration of its own FCC Construction Permit grant authorizing the community change. In order to implement the public interest benefits provided by KURR(FM)'s community change to Indian Springs so that it may be implemented, CBL, by this contingent set of applications, will specify replacing Hurricane, Utah's, sole local transmission service (KURR) with KBZB(FM)'s facilities operating on Channel 255C1 at its currently permitted site. In order to accommodate KBZB(FM)'s proposal, Dixie's Application will specify replacing Santa Clara's second permitted local transmission service (KBZB) with KXDS(FM)'s facilities operating on Channel 271C3 at its currently permitted site. A copy of this Memorandum of Agreement will form an attachment to each of the two Applications.

The Parties request that the FCC staff simultaneously process and grant their Applications for Minor-Change Construction Permits.


