

## EXHIBIT 14

### Television Channel 6 Protection

The proposed operation of K210AD conforms with the requirements of Section 74.1205 of the Commission's Rules with respect to providing protection to authorized TV stations on Channel 6. Under Section 74.1205(a) of the Rules, an application for new or modified facilities for an FM translator on Channel 210 needs to take into consideration all authorized Channel 6 TV stations located within 135 kilometers of the proposed FM translator site.

The only authorized TV Channel 6 station within 135 kilometers of the proposed K210AD site is KUHD-LP, Ventura, California, located 34.0 kilometers at a True bearing of 112.3 degrees from the proposed site. As shown in Figure 1 of this Exhibit, the proposed K210AD 73 dBu F(50,10) contour (the pertinent interfering contour for FM Channel 210 from Section 74.1205(c)(3) of the Rules) would not overlap the KUHD-LP Grade B 47 dBu F(50,50) contour. Accordingly, the proposed operation of K210AD would not result in interference to KUHD-LP.

The predicted FM translator contour shown in this Exhibit was based on data contained in this application, and was determined in accordance with the requirements of Section 73.313 of the Commission's Rules, from computerized calculations based on the NGDC 30-second terrain database and Figure 1a of Section 73.333 of the Rules. The predicted TV station contour shown in this Exhibit was based on data contained in the Commission's files, and was determined in accordance with the requirements of Section 73.684 of the Rules, from computerized calculations based on the NGDC 30-second terrain database and Figure 9 of Section 73.699 of the Rules. Distances to the contours were calculated at azimuthal increments of one degree.
