The Licensee previously operated at 50% power pursuant to special temporary authority ("STA") in File No. BDSTA-20060925AFP and extended in File No. BELDSTA-20070328ABR, which is scheduled to expire on May 18, 2008. On May 2, 2008, the Licensee completed its repairs and maintenance and returned to what it believed to be licensed operation. The Licensee wished to operate the facility at authorized parameters for a period of a week or so to ensure that everything was in order before notifying the Commission of resumption of authorized operation. Through the instant filing, the Licensee hereby notifies the Commission that the facility has been returned to nearly full licensed operation.

Since returning the facility to authorized operation, the Licensee has observed that operation at 100% power causes considerable distortion that is perceptible by viewers. The Licensee believes, but is not certain, that this situation is consistent with the natural deterioration of the tubes, which are approximately 6 years old. To correct for the distortion, the Licensee proposes to maintain its power around 90% of authorized power, at which level the distortion is adequately controlled. The Licensee plans to bring in a consultant to determine whether one or more of the ageing tubes requires replacement or whether a different solution is available. The Licensee intends to put in a conditional order for new tubes so that if the consultant determines a new tube is the proper remedy, the wait time for delivery will be reduced.

To the extent deemed necessary, the Licensee requests new STA to operate WATE-DT at slightly reduced power of 90%. This request proposes operation consistent with Licensee's DTV license (FCC File No. BMLCDT-20041203AEG), except that the station's ERP would be approximately 837 kW (i.e., 90% of the authorized 930 kW).

Because grant of the instant request for extension of STA would allow the Licensee to provide digital television service at nearly full authorized parameters, grant of the instant request would be in the public interest.
