

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

The Construction Permit contains several Special Operating Conditions, summarized as follows:

1. Waiver of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 was previously granted to allow operation of the facility authorized by this construction permit as a satellite operation of station KLVR-FM.
2. The Automatic Program Test provisions of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1602 do not apply; a formal request for Program Test Authority must be filed in conjunction with FCC Form 302-FM before Program Tests will be authorized.
3. The permittee/licensee must provide the results of proper radiofrequency electromagnetic (RF) field strength measurements throughout the transmitter site area to determine if there are any areas that exceed the FCC guidelines for human exposure to RF fields.
4. The permittee/licensee shall submit a statement certifying that a fence has been constructed at least two (2) meters from the base of the tower and in such a manner as to prevent the exposure of humans to radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC Guidelines.
5. The permittee/licensee must provide documentation demonstrating compliance with the preceding special operating condition.
6. The permittee/licensee, in coordination with other users of the site, must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
7. The permittee shall submit a certification that the antenna is mounted on an existing tower that is not base-insulated or detuned at the AM frequencies of AM stations KROE(AM), Sheridan, WY (FIN 38626) or KWYO(AM), Sheridan, WY (FIN 12942), or, otherwise, the applicant shall notify the AM stations, be responsible for readjustment and continued maintenance of any detuning apparatus necessary, and perform pre- and post-construction partial proofs of performance on the affected AM stations.

Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), complies with, or agrees to, these conditions, as follows:

1. EMF reiterates the commitments outlined in its request for waiver of section 73.1125. See also Exhibit 6.
2. The instant application constitutes a formal request for Program Test Authority.
3. No new fencing is required. See Exhibit 9A.

6. EMF agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
7. The antenna is mounted on an existing tower that is not base-insulated or detuned.

Therefore, all Special Operating Conditions of the KVLZ Construction Permit (FCC File Number BPED-20081103ADQ) have been met.
