Educational objective and how proposed station will be used to advance an educational program that will further that objective according to 47 C.F.R. Section 73.503

Redeemer Broadcasting, Inc. (RBI) has been producing non-commercial, educational radio programming since its inception. The current programs produced by RBI include the weekly evening program *Reflections* – an hour and one half program of sacred and classical music, including readings and devotional thought. A second program, called *Reflections on the Word*, is a 5 minute teaching feature that runs each day and is hosted by Dan Elmendorf and Dr. John Vance. A third program: *The Bible Class of the Air*, features Dr. John Vance, plus includes a half hour of music and readings hosted by Dan Elmendorf. Dr. Vance, in addition to serving as a local minister, is also a professor at SUNY in New Paltz, NY. These programs have currently been airing via WFSO and have received excellent listener feedback and consistent appreciation, as attested by listener letters.

Other syndicated programs are acquired by RBI and prepared for air play over WFSO. One popular program we have received positive feedback on is the program *Just Thinking*, with Dr. Ravi Zacharias. A few other programs RBI has worked to obtain permission to broadcast and obtained, are: *Every Last Word*, with Dr. Philip Ryken, *The Bible Study Hour* with Dr. James M. Boice, and the teaching/ministry program called *Songs in the Night* with Dr. Irwin Lutzer.

RBI's 24x7 programming over WFSO will include public affairs that are local to the Olivebridge area and the immediate surrounding communities. RBI programming will offer educational materials and Christian teaching that will benefit people who are older and shut into their homes, as well as offering materials for the entire family. With particular regard to shut-ins and those with eyesight challenges, RBI will offer complete Bible reading segments without comment.

RBI will provide a mix of fine sacred and classical music, teaching, public affairs, and include national news. Educational programming will include, and is not limited to, health and nutrition, human interest, home educational features and helps, interviews with educators and people knowledgeable in the community.

High quality book readings will be provided by RBI talent and these are planned for each weekday, and will start first, as weekend programs.

In the longer term, RBI plans to provide a magazine-of-the-air format during the morning drive time segment. The name of this program will be *Morning Magazine*.

These in short, are some of the educational goals of Redeemer Broadcasting, and are consistent we believe, with the intent of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.503.
