Consolidated Petition for Dismissal

Joint Request for Approval of Settlement
Agreement

Dear Ms. Harp, Mr. Reese, and Mr. McCormick:

The staff has under consideration: (1) the application of Larlen Communications, Inc. (“Larlen”) for minor modification of facilities for its Station WXPZ(FM), Clyde Township, Michigan;¹ and (2) the application of Michiana Christian Broadcasters, Inc. (“Michiana”) for minor modification of its Station WCWB(FM), Coldwater, Michigan,² which was both filed on the same day as Larlen’s WXPZ(FM) application and is mutually exclusive with that proposal. We also have before us Michiana’s August 21, 2008 “Consolidated Petition for Dismissal or Denial of License Applications and Cancellation of Construction Permits or, in the Alternative, Designation for Hearing” (the “Petition”),³ filed against Larlen’s pending covering license applications for both WXPZ(FM)⁴ and WDPW(FM), Greenville, Michigan.⁵ Finally, we have before us Larlen’s responses to staff inquiries concerning construction and operation of WXPZ(FM) and WDPW(FM)⁶ and a January 14, 2009, “Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement Agreement” (“Settlement Agreement”) filed by Michiana and Larlen. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement, Michiana will withdraw the Petition⁷ and Larlen will dismiss the WXPZ(FM) Modification Application, receiving reimbursement for expenses totaling \$4,500.⁸

We have reviewed both the Petition and the Settlement Agreement,⁹ as well as Larlen’s responses to the staff inquiries, and we find no reason for further consideration of the matters raised in the Petition. Additionally, we have determined that, under the terms of the Settlement Agreement, Larlen will receive no consideration for withdrawing the WXPZ(FM) Application in excess of its expenses, and Michiana will receive no monetary consideration for dismissing the Petition. Thus, the request for dismissal complies with Sections 73.3525 and 73.3588 of the Commission’s Rules.¹⁰

Finally, we have examined the WCWB(FM) Application, and we find that it complies with all pertinent statutory and regulatory requirements and that grant of that application will further the public interest, convenience, and necessity. We also have examined Larlen's pending covering license applications for WXPZ(FM) and WDPW(FM), and we find that all terms, conditions, and obligations set forth in the permit have been met. We will grant those applications below.


In light of the above findings, IT IS ORDERED, that the August 21, 2008, Consolidated Petition for Dismissal or Denial of License Applications and Cancellation of Construction Permits or, in the Alternative, Designation for Hearing, as supplemented on August 26, 2008, IS HEREBY DISMISSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the application of Larlen Communications, Inc. (File No. BMPED-20080715AEX) for modification of the construction permit for Station WXPZ(FM), Clyde Township, Michigan, IS DISMISSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the covering license applications of Larlen Communications, Inc. for Stations WXPZ(FM), Clyde Township, Michigan and WDPW(FM), Greenville, Michigan (File Nos. BLED-20080818AAI and BLED-20080818ABB, respectively) ARE GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the application of Michiana Christian Broadcasters, Inc. (File No. BMPED-20080715AEH) for modification of facilities for Station WCWB(FM), Coldwater, Michigan, IS GRANTED. These actions are taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.¹¹ The authorizations will follow under separate cover.
