
**Re: WURK(FM), Elwood, Indiana (FIN: 52508)**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 73.3517(a) of the Commission's rules, Backyard Broadcasting Indiana Licensee, LLC ("Backyard"), licensee of radio station WURK(FM), Elwood, Indiana, hereby grants permission to Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), the proposed assignee of the station (*see* FCC File No. BALH-20091007ACT), to file an FCC Form 302-FM application to request a waiver of the Commission's main studio rule and convert WURK to noncommercial educational status contingent upon the consummation of the assignment of WURK from Backyard to EMF. The application will be filed at EMF's expense prior to the closing. If the consummation of the assignment of WURK to EMF does not occur, EMF will request that the FCC dismiss the FCC Form 302-FM application as moot and return the station to its current specifications.
