Request for Waiver

By this application (the “Application”), John Burkavage (“Transferor”) and Harry Dixon and Bonnie Dixon (jointly, the “Transferee”) respectfully request Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) consent, *nunc pro tunc*, to the transaction, described herein, pursuant to which control of Big Horn Media, Inc., licensee of broadcast stations KUEZ (Facility ID 165338) and KUEZ-FM1 (Facility ID 181097) (“Licensee”), was transferred from Transferor to Transferee.

Prior to November 30, 2017, Licensee had issued 27 shares, jointly, as community property, to Transferor, as the sole shareholder, with 73 shares outstanding. On November 30, 2017, Transferor, Transferee and Licensee entered into a Buy/Sell Agreement and Stock Purchase Agreement to transfer 73 shares of outstanding common stock to Transferee jointly, as community property (the “Transaction”). However, due to an oversight, the parties did not request prior approval of the transaction as required by the Commission’s rules. When the parties became aware of the filing obligation, the parties filed the instant application.

Accordingly, the parties respectfully request a waiver of Section 73.3540 of the Commission’s rules and consent to the transaction *nunc pro tunc*. Good cause exists to grant the instant waiver request because it will permit the continued operations of the Licensee’s broadcast stations and bring the Licensee into compliance with the Commission’s rules.
