Dear Ms. Dortch:


Aleluya Broadcasting Network ("Aleluya"), by its attorney, hereby responds to the Commission's Letter dated September 18, 2017, with respect to interference complaints filed on August 2, 2017 by Gow Media, LLC, licensee of Station KFNC(FM), Mont Belvieu, Texas.

Station K248BD currently is already off the air on Channel 248 at the present time. Testing had commenced on the channel authorized in BPFT-20160610AAA, which evidently resulted in interference to co-channel Station KFNC. The Station was taken of the air on that channel in cooperation with Gow due to the reports of interference it apparently was receiving.

Aleluya does not intend to resume operations on that channel. Therefore, it should be deemed that investigations with respect to the individual complaints is not necessary at this time.
