
Re: WNZK (AM), Dearborn Heights, MI (FAC# 5348);
Notice of Operation at Reduced Power

Dear Madam Secretary:

On behalf of our client, Birach Broadcasting Corporation, the Licensee of AM Broadcast Station WNZK, Dearborn Heights, Michigan (the "Station"), and pursuant to Section 73.1560 of the Rules, we hereby notify the Commission that as of August 2, 2021, the Station began operating at twenty-five percent (25%) of authorized power due to a partial transmitter failure. The Licensee has ordered replacement parts for its transmitter and hopes to have the Station back up to full power in the next ten (10) days. In the event operations at reduced power extend beyond thirty (30) days, a formal request for Special Temporary Authority will be submitted.
