This statement is prepared on behalf Southwest Media, LLC permittee of Broadcast Station Construction Permit BMPCDT-20080630ADD, KCSG-DT (Facility No. 59494), Cedar City, Utah.

My name is Bernard M. VanBentham. I was the Chief Engineer on June 17, 2009, the date of the Digital Broadcast Station License application filing with the Federal Communications Commission and make the following statement of own free will and choice.

Construction Permit BMPCDT-20080630ADD special operating conditions or restrictions:


Condition #1 - The permittee should make a good faith effort to identify and notify health care facilities within the facility's service area potentially affected by the DTV operation. Documentation of the notifications and contacts made are in the Public Inspection File.

Declaration: The Permittee made a good faith effort to identify and notify health care facilities within the facility's service area and no adverse affects of interference or medical malfunctions have been caused by KCSG-DT operations.

Condition #2 - The permittee has taken adequate measures to identify and eliminate possible objectionable interference which may have caused existing land mobile radio facilities in the 460 to 470 MHz band.

Declaration: The Permittee took adequate measures to identify and eliminate possible objectionable interference caused by KCSG-DT operations. There has been no objectionable interference caused to land mobile radio facilities in the 460 to 470 MHz band caused by KCSG-DT operations.
