TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Legend Communications of Wyoming, LLC ("Legend"), authorized assignee of KKLX, Channel 241C2, Worland, Wyoming.¹ Legend herein proposes to make minor changes in the facilities of KKLX by relocating the station, increasing power, and upgrading to Channel 241C1.

Legend is proposing to locate the antenna system for KKLX on a new tower. As the tower is less than 200 feet, the Federal Aviation Administration was not apprised of this proposal. Further, the proposed tower does not require tower registration, based on a review using the Commission's TOWAIR program. Since the proposed KKLX antenna will be mounted on a relatively short tower, the worksheets associated with FCC Form 301 could not be used to certify compliance with the radio frequency radiation limits. Therefore, attached as Exhibit A is a study showing this proposal complies with the Commission's RF exposure limits.

All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to Legend and is available to the Commission upon request.²

 - 2) For the purposes of environmental analysis, only the radio frequency radiation evaluation was undertaken by Graham Brock, Inc. The applicant is completing review the balance of the environmental reviews (i.e., location of site near areas of historic importance, Indian or tribal areas, etc.). Once the review is completed, this instant application will be amended accordingly.
