Dear Licensee:

Board of Supervisors, Louisiana State University & A&M College ("LSU") is hereby notified of the modification of its license for KLSA(FM), Alexandria, LA, to specify operation on Channel 214C0.

On September 13, 2013, Valleydale Broadcasting, LLC ("Valleydale"), licensee of a new station in Colfax, LA, filed a minor change construction permit application. Valleydale's application proposed that KLSA's license be modified to specify Class C0 in lieu of Class C in accordance with the procedures set forth in Note 4 of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3573.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, by staff letter dated November 13, 2013, KLSA was directed to show cause why its license should not be modified to specify Channel 214C0 in lieu of Channel 214C. The letter stated that failure to respond to this letter within thirty days will result in the automatic downgrade of KLSA. As of the date of this letter, KLSA has failed to file a response to the November 13, 2013 letter, and thus, has consented to the downgrade.
