Communications Site Management, LLC ("CSM"), licensee of low power television station W11BJ, hereby confirms its certification that W11BJ does, and will continue to broadcast: (a) a minimum of 18 hours per day; and (b) an average of at least 3 hours per week of programming each quarter produced within the market area served by the station. The station is currently operating pursuant to a low power Special Temporary Authority ("STA"). See FCC File No. BSTA-2004120AGS.

In the interest of full disclosure, CSM notes that W11BJ was off-the-air for a significant part of the past two years pursuant to STA granted by the Commission. See e.g. FCC File No. BRSTA-20031006ACH (10/20/03). W11BJ fully complied with the statutory requirements for Class A status when its initial class A application was filed. Due to the Commission's five-year delay in acting on its initial displacement application, W11BJ was unable to remain on the air continuously between April 2002 and April 2004. See FCC File No. BPTVL-19980601QZ. Following the grant of a second displacement application in January 2004, see FCC File No. BPTTL-20021112AAX, W11BJ again operates for 18 hours per day with an average of at least three hours of local programming per week.
